The Mobile Fleet Operator operates a variety of mobile plant equipment, inclusive of Dumpers (haulage trucks) and Front-End Loaders used in Quarrying operations, as well as assists in their maintenance and repairs.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operates trucks of various sizes and weights in the loading, hauling, and unloading of various equipment, materials, and supplies.
- Operates trucks and power equipment, such as backhoes, man-lift, dump trucks, front-end loaders, hydraulic excavators, and skid steers.
- Works with and assists the line crew in digging ditches and trenches, hoisting material, tools, equipment, and any related work with a backhoe, or front-end loader.
- Performs routine inspection and preventive maintenance on assigned equipment and refers defects or repairs to the supervisor; cleans equipment.
- Performs all duties in conformance to appropriate safety and security standards.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

- Ability to read and understand technical instructions related to the operations of mobile plant and equipment
- Minimum of five (5) years' experience involving the use of medium and heavy equipment.
